

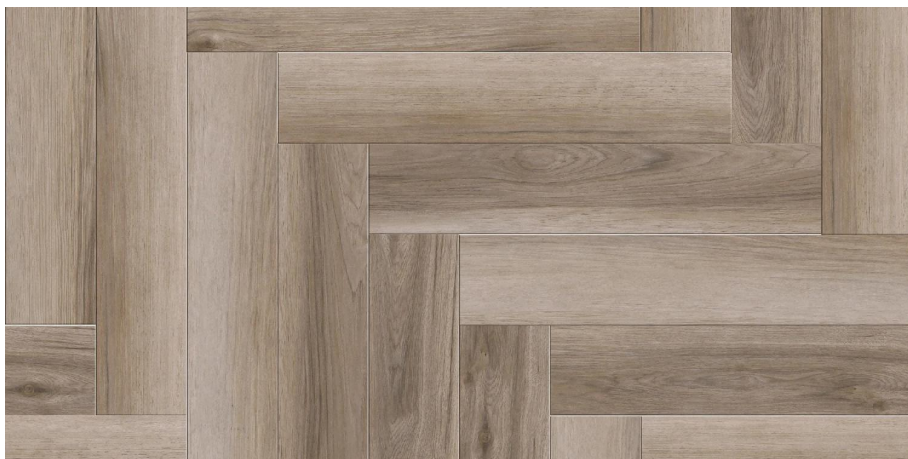

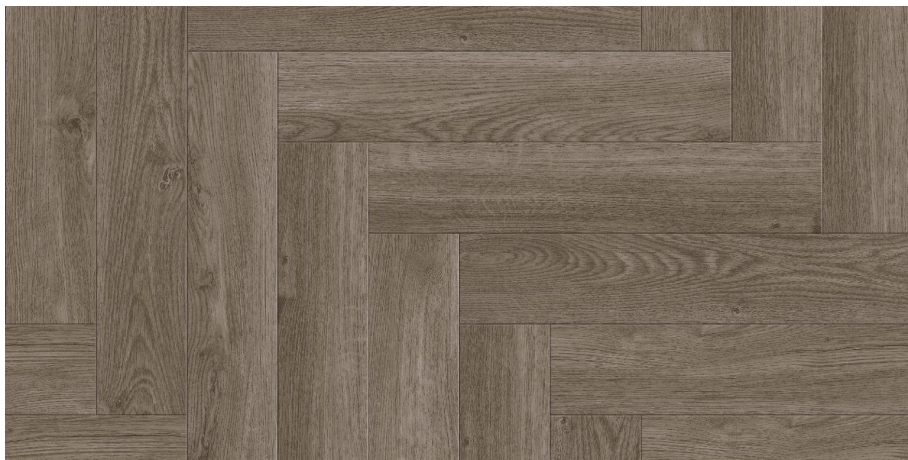


2602H **Baltic Shores Wild Oak**

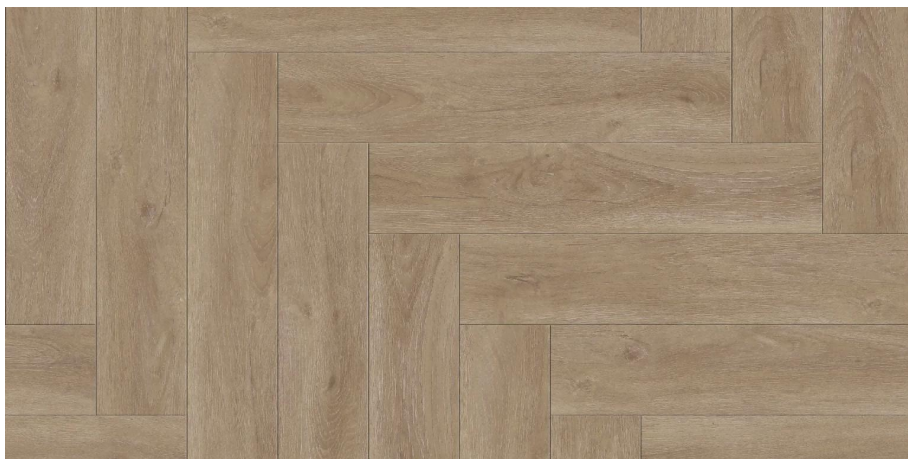


2160H **Bohemian Clay Ridge Oak**

The expansive surface layout remains clean and sophisticated, completely free of aggressive or heavy knots.





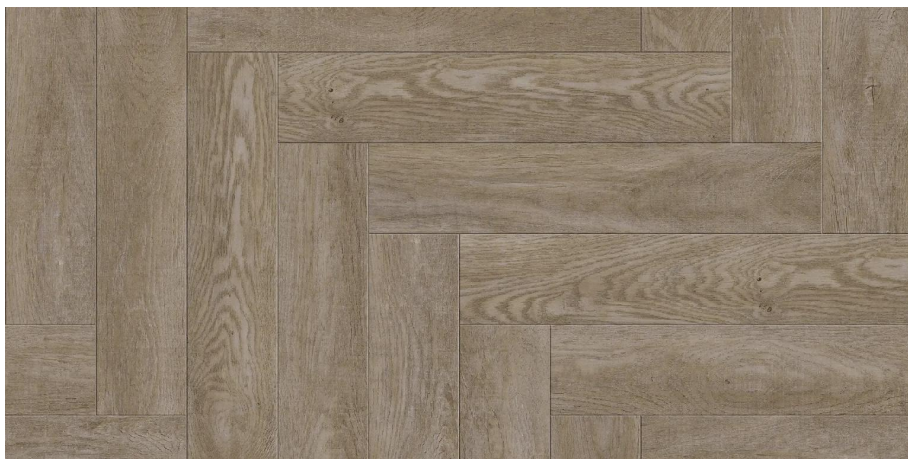

It showcases a highly expressive wood structure where beautifully undulating, wide-set cathedral arches transition into tight, prominent linear grain sequences.

Evokes a raw, unrefined coastal elegance, beautifully capturing the spirit of a windsourced Nordic landscape across the organic variations. It introduces a highly authentic, medium-contrast wood structure where beautifully defined cathedral arches flow seamlessly alongside subtle micro-cracks and weathered grain fissures.
